On November 11th, several of our students attended a tour of the <u>National Building</u> <u>Arts Center</u> in Sauget, Illinois. The Center is an emerging center of




study housing the nation's largest collection of building artifacts. It was impressive to see the wide variety of artifacts they have from the St. Louis region and elsewhere!


